## Student Attitudes to School Survey 2024 Results

The preliminary Student Attitude to School results have been released to schools. We are really happy to see that our school survey reflects high positive endorsement from this year's Year 4 - 6 students.

We had a strong participation rate of 98% of our students completing the online survey.

Our Four Year School Strategic Plan is focusing our school's work in the following improvement areas:

### Student Learning:

- Stimulated Learning – will increase to 85%. Our 2024 student endorsement reflects 91%.
- Learning Confidence – will increase to 85%. Our 2024 student endorsement reflects 86%.

### Student Wellbeing:

- Student Voice & Agency – will increase to 80%. Our 2024 student endorsement reflects 84%.
- Perseverance – will increase to 85%. Our 2024 student endorsement reflects 82%.
- Effort – will increase to 90%. Our 2024 student endorsement reflects 88%.

Our school is also focused on improving the following areas as well as the above:

- School Connectedness – 2024 student endorsement reflects 88%.
- Respect for diversity – 2024 student endorsement reflects 87%.
- Managing Bullying – 2024 student endorsement reflects 87%.
- Sense of Inclusion - 2024 student endorsement reflects 95%.
- Attitudes to Attendance - 2024 student endorsement reflects 94%.
- Stimulated Learning Environment - 2024 student endorsement reflects 91%.
- Differentiated Learning Challenge - 2024 student endorsement reflects 93%.



Our data reflects strong and positive towards both our school strategic targets as well across our annual improvement variables as well.

This data is certainly reflecting that our students see and recognise the school improvements that our staff are implementing across learning and teaching and student wellbeing.

Areas that our school will continue to focus on and strengthen through Term Three and Term Four include:

- Managing Bullying - 2024 student endorsement reflects 87%.
- Students at this school treat teachers with respect - 78%.
- Students at this school treat each other with respect - 74%.

However, overall, our results certainly continue to reflect the high level work our school dedicates and is committed to in building and strengthening our positive school culture.

## Who can be a foster carer?

There is no 'typical' Berry Street foster carer. Just as every family is different, our foster carers come from diverse backgrounds, cultures and experiences.

Our foster carers:

- are a minimum of 21 years of age
- have a spare bedroom to offer a child or young person
- can be single, married or in a de facto relationship
- can be from LGBTIQ+ communities
- can come from any religion, spirituality or nationality
- may or may not have children of their own
- can be in casual, part-time or full-time work – or perhaps not at all
- live in a home they rent or own

Berry Street foster carers have a passion for supporting others and are committed to providing a safe home for children and young people who need it.

The care and support they provide connects them to something bigger than themselves.

## What are the types of care?

Our team will work with you to find the type of foster care that suits you and your family. It could be long-term care, just for a short time, or on an occasional basis.

## What support do foster carers receive?



### Financial assistance

Foster carers receive a fortnightly caregiver reimbursement.



### Tailored support

Expert support along the way from our friendly and approachable team.



### Continuous growth

Ongoing training and development opportunities.



### Connected community

Networking events and celebrations to recognise, thank and connect our carers.
