### **Student Wellbeing**

### Whole School Incursion - Social Emotional Learning

Our students will enjoy a whole school incursion focusing on building and supporting important social and emotional learning skills and understandings.

Brainstorm Productions are an educational performance company who specialise their performances around key social and emotional learnings for children. They are fun, upbeat and engaging for students of all ages - our students will love it!

Following this performance our teachers will extend students' learning within the classroom with activities that will reinforce and extend student learning.

FOCUS: Being Brave - student wellbeing and resilience social and emotional support strategies.

I am really pleased to advise that Frankston Primary School is covering the cost of this incursion again this year, through further funding that the school has received in supporting positive mental health in children.



### **Art Therapy - supporting students**

We have been lucky to be able to access further funding from School Focused Youth Service for 2025 to support students - which is amazing

- In 2023 we were able to support selected 5/6 students through a short term Martial Arts Therapy Program.
- In 2024 we accessed funding to run an 8 week
   Art Therapy Program building and utilising the creativity of art in supporting student wellbeing.
- In 2025 we have successfully accessed funding for a second year of Art Therapy for selected students.

This is a great way for our school to support students on top of our student wellbeing supports including our social worker 2 days, and our additional teacher in a role one day a week supporting student mental health.

### **Student SSG Meetings**

SSG Meetings (Student Support Group) will occur in Term Two primarily through Weeks 4—6.

Parents and Carers with a child who has designated Student Support Group Meetings (SSG) have been included in a SSG Class Dojo group for communication purposes.

Information about booking an SSG for your child has been sent through Class Dojo, along with the booking link.

We are hoping that this system will bring a streamlined consistent approach to scheduling SSGs across our school each term - supporting parents and carers with a clear process and timeline.






